## CHAPTER 134.

Passed March 4, 1858.

AN ACT appropriating a sum of money in payment for legal services rendered by Brice J. Goldsborough, Esq., at the request of the Governor of this State.

Treasurer authorised.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby directed to pay unto Brice J. Goldsborough the sum of fifty dollars in part payment for legal services rendered by him at the request of the Governor of this State in the prosecution of Solomon Wilson, for murder, in the Circuit Court for Talbot county, and said sum of fifty dollars is hereby appropriated out of any unexpended money in the treasury.

## CHAPTER 135.

Passed March 4, 1858.

AN ACT for the benefit of the representatives of Daniel Benson, deceased.
