

and directed to pay to William W. Johnson, of Somerset county, the sum of one hundred and thirty-eight dollars and nineteen cents, the same being an amount of so much money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury of the State.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 146.

AN ACT for the relief of Joshua Brown, of Anne Arundel county.

Passed March 1, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Joshua Brown, of Anne Arundel county, be and he is hereby authorised, entitled and empowered, to have, hold, own and keep, in the State of Maryland, a certain negro man, named Tom Boteler, as his slave for life, sold under the act of eighteen hundred and forty-nine, chapter one hundred and twenty-four, entitled "a supplement to an act respecting the punishment of slaves," and purchased by the said Joshua Brown, as a slave for life, as aforesaid.

Authorised to hold slave.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
