

CHAPTER 156.

AN ACT to allow Hezekiah E. Willet, late collector of taxes, in the third election district of Charles county, further time to complete his collections.

Passed February 17, 1858.

SECTION. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, Hezekiah E. Willet, late collector in the third election district of Charles county, by himself or any person or persons by him appointed for this purpose, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect, until the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, all sums and balances due him, as collector of said third election district in said county, in the same manner which the said Hezekiah E. Willet, could or might have done within the time now limited by law; *Provided,* that nothing in this act shall be construed, to prevent the Comptroller from enforcing payment of any sums that may be due the State by said collector.

Further time to make collections.

Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That it shall be the duty of the said Hezekiah E. Willet, before he proceeds to execute the property of any person or persons, for taxes in virtue of this act, to deliver to such person or persons chargeable with the same, at least thirty days previous to the laying of such execution, a fair account in writing, of the taxes demanded of him, her or them, and an affidavit thereto annexed, that he hath not directly or indirectly received any part thereof, or any thing in security or satisfaction for the same, more than the credits given, to the best of his knowledge.

Duty before executing property.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That all acts inconsistent with this act, be and the same are hereby repealed.

In force.
