SEC. 9. And be it enacted, That the limits of Limits. the said Village of Port Tobacco shall be established, marked and bounded by the Commissioners first elected, as soon after their election as may be practicable, and recorded among their proceed-

SEC. 10. And be it enacted, That the said Com- Clerk to be apmissioners or a majority of them shall have pow-pointed. er to appoint a clerk and assign his duties, and allow him such compensation as they may think proper; and that all ordinances passed by the said Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall by their clerk be entered in a book by him to be kept for that purpose; and shall be open at all times for the inspection of any person interested; and copies of all ordinances shall be put up in the most public places in said Village, that the same may be generally known.

SEC 11. And be it enacted, That the said Commissioners shall have full power and authority to to levy. levy and collect taxes in said Village, not exceeding in any one year twenty cents in the hundred dollars on the assessable property of said Village; and for the purpose of making said levy, they shall once in every two years, or oftener if they think proper, appoint an assessor who shall under oath, value, appraise and assess the property in

said Village.

SEC. 12. And be it enacted, That if any of the May appeal. owners of property assessed within said Village shall conceive themselves aggrieved by the assessment so as aforesaid made by said assessors they may appeal to the said President and Commissioners, who shall have power and authority to make such deduction on the valuation of their property

as they shall deem just.

SEC. 13. And be it enacted, That the said Commissioners be and they are hereby empowered to dinances and by-laws. pass all by-laws and ordinances necessary to give effect and operation to all the powers vested in this corporation; to impose fines, penalties and forfeitures for any breach of their by-laws and ordinances; Provided, that no ordinance of the Proviso. said Commissioners shall impose a fine or forfei-
