#### CHAPTER 181.

Passed March 4, 1858.

AN ACT to appropriate a sum of money, to pay Charles S. Middleton, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county, for certain fees due him by the State.

Treasurer authorised to pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorised and directed to pay to the order of Charles S. Middleton, Clerk of the Circuit Court for Prince George's county, the sum of thirty-two dollars and ninety cents, being the amount of fees due him from the State for the years eighteen hundred and fifty-six and seven.
