Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assem- Orphans' Court bly of Maryland, That the Orphans' Court of provide a new Somerset county, be and they are hereby author-seal. ised to provide a new seal for the said court, (if they shall deem the same necessary) at the expense of the said county, provided the cost of the same shall not exceed the sum of seventy-five dollars.

And be it enacted, That the said Orphans' Court are hereby authorised and empowered to cause such alterations and repairs to be made in the office of the Register of Wills for Somerset county, as they may deem necessary for the preservation of the records and papers in said office, and that the expenses thereof be levied on the assessable property of said county, at the next annual levy to be made by the Commissioners of said county.
