defendant is a non resident, the Company may proceed by attachment, and any property on said road in his possession, shall be taken and held as the property of said defendant.

CHAPTER 188.

5, 1858. AN ACT for the establishment of a system of Public Schools in Somerset county.

ARTICLE I.

OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

Commissioners appointed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That on the first Tuesday of June, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-eight, and on the first Tuesday of September in every second year thereafter, there shall be appointed one person in each Election District of Somerset county, by the Judges of the Orphans' Court thereof, to be Commissioners of Public Schools, and to whom commissions shall be issued by said Judges immediately after the said appointment, to be denominated "The Board of Commissioners of Public Schools, of Somerset county."
