Three thousand dollars being subscribed Comptroller to issue warrant.

SEC. 7. And be it enacted, That upon a certificate being filed by the said trustees or their successors, under oath, with the Comptroller of the Treasury, that the sum of three thousand dollars has been subscribed in stock, by good and responsible men, for the erection of buildings for the use of said Academy, it shall be the duty of said Comptroller, to issue his warrant to the Treasurer for the payment of the sum of five hundred dollars, to the said trustees or their successors in office, to be used and expended by them for the purpose of female education, and he shall annually issue his warrant to the Treasurer, upon the order of the said trustees or their successors in office, for the same amount.

SEC. 8. And be it enacted, That the sum of five hundred dollars, annually, be and the same is hereby appropriated, out of any unappropriated funds in the Treasury, for the purpose aforesaid.
