

CHAPTER 203.

Passed March 9, 1858.

AN ACT, amendatory of an act, entitled an act to provide for the formation of corporations for Moral, Scientific, Dramatic, Agricultural or Charitable purposes, &c, passed May thirteenth, eighteen hundred and fifty-two, chapter two hundred and thirty-one.

Commissioner of Land Office
Authorised to receive property by gift or otherwise.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Church Home and Infirmary of the city of Baltimore, a corporation incorporated in the city of Baltimore, under the act of eighteen hundred and fifty-two, chapter two hundred and thirty-one, be hereby declared capable of receiving, recovering, holding and enjoying all property, real, personal or mixed, which may have been heretofore given to it, or which it may hereafter acquire by gift, devise, bequest or otherwise; *Provided,* that the amount of property, so acquired and held, shall not exceed the sum or value of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage.

CHAPTER 204.

Passed March 9, 1858.

AN ACT to authorise the Commissioner of the Land Office to make such correction in the courses or outlines of the tract of land called "Love in a Village," both in the original certificate of survey, and in the patent thereof, as shall make the same correspond with the original plat on file in said office.
