AN ACT to incorporate "The Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Kent Island, Queen Anne's County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Robert W. Eareckson, Edward Hopkins, Thomas H. Kemp, William S. Thompson, William Goldsborough, Charles Stevens, Richard T. Carter, Samuel W. Carter, Alexander W. Thompson, Charles E. Skinner, James M. Stevens, and all other persons who may hereafter associate with them in the manner hereinafter prescribed be, and they are hereby incorporated by the name of "The Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Kent Island," for the purpose of insuring their respective dwelling houses, manufactories, mills, stores, shops and other buildings, merchandise, household furniture, grain, hay and other property, against loss or damage by fire; and by such name shall have succession to sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, in any court of law or equity in this State, to have,

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
