CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT to change the name of Jacob Morris to John David Hanson. Passed January 28, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the name of Jacob Morris, of Charles county, in the State of Maryland, be and the same is hereby changed to John David Hanson; and it shall be lawful for the said Jacob Morris, at all times hereafter, to be called and known by, hold and use the name of John David Hanson, and by that name to hold, receive, purchase, sell, convey or devise property, whether real or personal, and to sue and be sued in any court of law or equity, or elsewhere. Name changed.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 30.

AN ACT to authorise the Trustees of Churchville Presbyterian Congregation to hold certain real estate. Passed January 29, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the trustees of the Churchville Presbyterian Congregation, in Harford county, be, and they are hereby authorised, to purchase and hold in fee simple, to them and their Trustees authorised to purchase.
