

tion which may be brought to the established depots of said railroad or railroads for the transportation under the restriction above stated.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to give to the said company banking privileges; and the Legislature hereby reserves the right to alter, amend or repeal the charter hereby created.

Banking privileges prohibited.

SEC. 11. *And be it enacted*, That this corporation shall be required to make an annual statement of their affairs under the oath or affirmation of their President, to be published once a week for four successive weeks in one or more of the newspapers in the cities of Cumberland and Baltimore.

Required to make annual statement of affairs.

SEC. 12. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

In force.

CHAPTER 235.

AN ACT to lay off and establish a new election district in Dorchester county, to be called Election District Number Twelve, or Williamsburg District.

Passed March 2, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That a new election district be formed and established, and the same is hereby established in Dorchester county, out of election district number two, otherwise called New Market district, in said county, to be called and known by the name of Williamsburg district.

New election District.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the boundaries of said election district shall be as follows, beginning at the bridge over the Nanticoke river, at Federalsburg, thence with the county road that separates Dorchester from Caroline county, to Hunting Creek, thence with said creek to Chop-tank river, thence with said river to Blink Horn Creek, thence with said creek to its head, or until it intersects the county road leading from Cabin creek to Hunting creek, thence with the Manor

Boundaries.
