

SEC. 4. *Be it enacted*, That in the execution of the powers conferred upon them by this act, the Mayor and City Council shall have full power and authority to prescribe the mode of ascertaining the value in money of the several kinds and descriptions of property above referred to, and made assessable within said city, and for adjusting and settling all differences in relation thereto, and generally to do all other matters and things which may be necessary and proper for ascertaining and determining by a fair and just valuation the actual assessable property subject to assessment in said city; *Provided*, that nothing herein contained in this act shall authorise the said Mayor and City Council to assess and collect any tax on any property which is now liable under existing laws in Baltimore county, or any other county in this State.

Mayor and City Council to have full power and authority.

Proviso.

SEC. 5. *Be it enacted*, That when the new assessment is completed the same shall be chargeable according to such valuation with the taxes levied for the use of this State, which shall be levied according to such new assessment.

Assessment.

SEC. 6. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage.

CHAPTER 242.

AN ACT to provide for the election of an additional Supervisor of Public Roads in the First Election District in Worcester county.

Passed March 2, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That at the next general election of delegates, and at every general election thereafter, there shall be elected in the first election district of Worcester county, by the qualified voters thereof, two supervisors of public roads in said district.

Two Supervisors to be elected.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That one of said persons elected as supervisor of public roads as aforesaid, shall be a resident of that part of the
