CHAPTER 34.

AN ACT to refund to Lydia Knox, of Worcester county, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury.

Passed January 28, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorised and directed upon the warrant of the Comptroller to pay to Lydia Knox, of Worcester county, the sum of twelve dollars and fifty cents, being the amount erroneously paid by said Lydia for a license.

Treasurer to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
