

inspector general shall fail to make the return to the Treasurer, provided by this act, to send a copy of his bond to the State's Attorney for the city of Baltimore, to be put in suit, whose duty it shall be to proceed thereon for the speedy recovery of the penalty thereof, as upon any other official bond.

Inspectors only to weigh and measure.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That no person, except those appointed under the provisions of this act, shall inspect, weigh or measure any grain within the city of Baltimore, that may arrive for sale, upon the penalty of twenty-five dollars for every offence, to be recovered in the name of the State, for the use of the informer, before any justice of the peace in and for the city of Baltimore.

Power to appoint assistants.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That the inspector general shall have power to appoint as many assistants, weighers and measurers of grain as the demands of trade require, and affix their compensation, provided it shall not be more than one fourth of a cent per bushel, one half to be paid by the buyer and the other half by the seller, and dismiss them for neglect of or improper discharge of duty, but before said measurers shall perform any duty under this act, each shall take an oath before some justice of the peace for the faithful and impartial performance of the duties of the office.

Weights and measures.

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That the inspector General shall provide the necessary weights and scales, and measures for carrying out the provisions of this act, and see that they are kept in proper condition, and the Treasurer is hereby authorised and directed, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to pay to the inspector general, out of his first instalment into the Treasury, the cost of said weights, scales and measures.

Treasurer to open an account.

SEC. 18. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer shall be and he is hereby required to open an account with the grain inspection fund, and credit to said account or fund all moneys paid into the Treasury in pursuance of this act, and the surplus of fees that may hereafter be received from any inspector holding under the provisions of any other law, and pay the amount provided for in this act, and charge them to said fund, and
