

- all contracts made by or for the said Company, and for all just claims against the same; and a majority of the stockholders, representing a majority of the stock of said Company, may at any time dissolve the Corporation; *Provided*, that all contracts with, and suits by or against the same, shall not be impaired or affected by such dissolution.
- Proviso.**
- In force.** SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall go into effect from the date of its passage.
- Reservation.** SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That the Legislature reserves to itself the right to amend, alter or repeal this act.

CHAPTER 37.

Passed January 25, 1858. AN ACT to confer certain authority herein mentioned upon the Board of Primary School Inspectors for Frederick county.

Authority to sell. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Board of Primary School Inspectors for Frederick county shall have full and competent authority to sell the primary school house in Franklin school district, No. five, of said county, whenever the said Board of Inspectors shall have divided said district.

Money apportioned. SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, that the monies accruing from the sale of said school house shall be equally apportioned by said Board of Inspectors between the two new school districts thus created, for the purpose of erecting buildings in said districts for primary school purposes.

In force. SEC. 3. *Be it enacted*, That this bill shall take effect from the date of its passage.
