Exempted from taxation.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That all estate and estates, and property, real, personal and mixed, of every nature and kind whatsoever, which has heretofore been, or which may hereafter be given, devised, or bequeathed to the Sheppard Asylum, or to the Trustees of the Sheppard Asylum, for the use and benefit of said Asylum, shall be, and the same, and every part thereof, are hereby entirely released, discharged, and forever exempt from the tax or duty imposed by the act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-four, chapter 237, entitled, an act imposing a tax on collateral inheritances, distributive shares and legacies, to aid in paying the debts of the State, or of any supplemental act to the said last mentioned act of Assembly; and that no part of such estate, or estates or property aforesaid, shall, in any manner, be liable for the payment of said tax or duty,
