And be it enacted, That said battalion, is authorised to receive in addition to its complement of officers and men, one hundred contributing or honorary members, each of whom upon the payment of ten dollars annually, shall be entitled to all the privileges and exemptions originally granted to the officers and men of the First Light Division of Maryland Volunteers, and by the act of Assembly, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-five, chapter sixty-nine, to the honorary or contributing members of the Eagle Artillery Company of Baltimore.
