

CHAPTER 310.

AN ACT to grant a donation to the Brookeville Academy, in Montgomery county. Passed March 9, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That there be and is hereby appropriated the annual sum of four hundred dollars, to be paid by the Treasurer of Maryland to the Trustees of Brookeville Academy in Montgomery county, or their order, in addition to the donation of two hundred dollars, already granted to said Academy, for the use and benefit of said Institution; *Provided,* the Trustees of said Academy shall annually elect one indigent pupil, for each hundred dollars they receive from the State, and supply with books and stationery, and give gratuitous instruction to said indigent pupils, and otherwise comply with the requisitions of the original act and its supplements, granting donations to the different Colleges and Academies of this State. Sum appropriated.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall go into effect on and after the first day of April, eighteen hundred and fifty-eight. To take effect.

CHAPTER 311.

AN ACT authorising the County Commissioners for Washington county, to enlarge, extend, modify or add to the Court House in Washington county, and to levy a sum of money for the cost thereof. Passed March 9, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners for Washington county, be and they are hereby authorised and empowered, to change, modify, extend or add to the present Court House building in the said county, at Hagerstown, and to levy the amount of cost thereof, upon the taxable property Commissioners authorised to levy.
