AN ACT to empower the board of Commissioners of Washington county to lay off a new election district in said county, to be composed of parts of election districts number three and number four in said county, and to cause the polls thereof to be held at Cunningham's Cross Roads.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That for the greater convenience of voting in Washington county, it shall be lawful from and after the passage of this act for the Commissioners of Washington county, or a majority of them, to lay off a new election district in said county, the same to be formed out of election districts known as number three and four in said county.
