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forty-one, eighteen hundred and forty-two, eighteen hundred and forty-three and eighteen hundred and forty-four, according to the amounts charged against him for said years, upon the books of the County Commissioners, of Somerset county.

AND WHEREAS, it is represented to this General Preamble.

Assembly, That the said William H. Jones did not receive any interest upon the taxes for said years, collected by him previous to the operation of the act of Assembly passed at December session, eighteen hundred and fortyfive, chapter two hundred and three, section five; Therefore,

SECTION 2. Be it enacted by the General Assem- Interest not to be charged. bly of Maryland, That the Comptroller, be and he is hereby authorised, in the settlement of the accounts of the said William H. Jones, as collector for said years, not to charge any interest against the said collector, upon so much of said taxes as were collected and paid into the treasury by him, before the first day of June, eighteen hundred and forty-six.

SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That this act shall In force. take effect from its passage.
