

## CHAPTER 48.

Passed February 1, 1858.

AN ACT to grant the leave of the Legislature to a sale of land to the Vestry of St. Paul's Parish, in Calvert county.

Consent of Legislature given to sale.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the leave of the Legislature be, and the same is hereby given to the sale of land made by Richard H. Hagner, Trustee, and Richard Hance and wife, to the Vestry of St. Paul's Parish, in Calvert county, by deed dated the thirtieth day of August, in the year eighteen hundred and fifty-six, and recorded in Liber N. D., No. 1., Folio 777, &c., one of the land record books of Calvert county; and the said sale is hereby declared valid.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
