

CHAPTER 333.

AN ACT to provide for the compensation of William F. Frick, for certain services rendered by him under the appointment of the Governor, in pursuance of an order passed by the House of Delegates of Maryland, February the fourth eighteen hundred and fifty-four, and for an argument made in the Supreme Court of the United States.

Passed March 8, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to William F. Frick, the sum of four hundred dollars, in full compensation for services rendered the State by him, under an appointment by the Governor of Maryland, in pursuance of an order, passed by the House of Delegates, on the fourth day of February, eighteen hundred and fifty-four, and for an argument in the Supreme Court of the United States, in the case of Jonathan Huddleson, former superintendent of the National Road vs. Stockton, Falls and Co.

Treasurer authorised to pay.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 334.

AN ACT to amend the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Old Road Turnpike Company, in Baltimore county.

Passed March 9, 1858.
