G. Letourneau, for repairing clock in the hall of the House of Delegates; for the payment of William J. Jewell, for glazing seven glasses for State House; for the payment of George W. Beckenbaugh, for services rendered as Committee Clerk; for the payment of John Wesley White, for articles furnished for the House of Delegates and Senate of Maryland; and for the payment of James Murray, for services as clerk in Land Office, under resolution eighty-five, of eighteen hundred and thirty-one.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is authorised to pay to Collins, Heath and Hutchinson, seventy dollars; to Scott and Wilson, three hundred and one dollars; to John H. Slaymaker, seventeen dollars and twenty-five cents; to Lewis Gootee, two hundred dollars; to J. S. Merriken, one hundred and seventy-five dollars; to James Branzell, twenty-four dollars; to William Freeman, one hundred and ten dollars and eighty-eight cents; to H. G. Letourneau, six dollars; to William J. Jewell, two dollars; to George W. Beckenbaugh, twenty-eight dollars; to John Wesley White, four hundred and forty-six dollars and fifteen cents; to James Murray, forty-one dollars and sixty-one cents.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after its passage.
