SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Jefferson Division, number one hundred and sixty-three, of the Sons of Temperance, are hereby authorised, to erect an additional story upon the Primary School House, in Jefferson School District of Frederick county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That when such said story shall have been completed and finished into a suitable Hall, for meetings and other uses, as approved by said Division, that the exclusive right to said Hall shall vest and remain in said Division, so long as said Division shall maintain its distinctive organization.
