

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer, Treasurer to pay.  
 on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is authorized to pay J. Wesley White, three thousand and twenty-five dollars and five cents; to Paul Martin, forty dollars; to Mary R. Sullivan, fifteen dollars.

CHAPTER 350.

AN ACT for the relief of the sureties on the official bond of John W. Wilbourn, former collector of State taxes, for the Second Collection District of Calvert county. Passed March 9, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sureties on the official bond of John W. Wilbourn, former collector for the Second Collection District of Calvert county, be and they are hereby released from the payment of interest on the State's claim against said Wilbourn; *Provided*, that the amount due for principal, costs and charges on said claim, shall be paid into the treasury on or before the first day of August next. Released from payment of interest.
