Be it enacted by the General Assem- Free people of bly of Maryland, That no free person of color, or color or slave slave, shall have or use any row boat or other boat. boat on the Potomac river or shore thereof, in Charles or Prince George's county, without, in case of a free person of color, first obtaining a license from a justice of the peace of the respective county, and in case of a slave, the special
