

CHAPTER 357.

A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled an act to incorporate a company to construct a Turnpike Road from Hagerstown, in Washington county, to Smithburg, passed January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter two hundred and forty-nine, so as to permit the County Commissioners of Washington county, to make an additional subscription to the capital stock of said company, and to authorise the President and directors of said company, to change the location of the gates on said road.

Passed March 10, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the board of Commissioners of Washington county be, and they are hereby empowered to make a further subscription of fifty shares to the capital of the Hagerstown and Smithburg Turnpike Company, if in their opinion it shall be expedient for them to do so.

Commissioners empowered to make further subscriptions.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That the President and directors of said road are hereby empowered to change the location of the gates on said road.

May change location of the gates.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 358.

AN ACT to incorporate the Port Deposit Library Association.

Passed March 10, 1858.
