CHAPTER 360.

AN ACT to provide for the compensation of James M. Schley for certain services performed by him under the appointment of the Governor in the Court of Appeals of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer be and he is hereby directed to pay upon the warrant of the Comptroller to James M. Schley, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, in full compensation for arguments made by him, under an appointment by the Governor of Maryland, in the case of Andrew Brash *vs.* the State, and in the case of George Kellenbeck *vs.* the State.
