AN ACT appropriating a sum of money for the payment of the claims of John W. Davis, James Hopkins, James H. League, J. Wesley White, John E. Stalker and Richard Brashears.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of three hundred and eighty-four dollars and seventy-nine cents, be and the same is hereby appropriated for the payment of the claims of John W. Davis, for window blinds furnished the State House, for the payment of James Hopkins, for re-hanging two pictures in Senate Chamber, for the payment of James H. League, for mending lamps; for the payment of J. Wesley White, for articles furnished the Library; for the payment of John E. Stalker, for repairs done to the State House, for the payment of Richard Brashears, for desk and screens furnished for the Senate Chamber.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer on the warrant of the Comptroller, be and he is authorised to pay John W. Davis, twenty-four dollars; to James Hopkins, five dollars, to James H. League, three dollars; to J. Wesley White, one hundred and eighty dollars and twelve cents; to John E. Stalker, twenty-seven dollars and sixty seven cents, and to Richard Brashears, forty-five dollars.
