A SUPPLEMENT to an act, entitled an act, for Passed March 6, 1858. the better protection of Stevens' Ferry, passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-four, chapter one hundred and fifty-six.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be the duty of the missioners. County Commissioners of Somerset and Worcester counties, to levy upon the taxable property of said counties, in the hands of their respective Sheriffs, twelve months in advance, annually, a sufficient amount, or sum of money for the purchase of a rope or ropes for Stevens' Ferry, on the Pokomoke river in said counties, and said Sheriffs, shall upon the order of the keeper or keepers of the said ferry, pay over to him or them
