

CHAPTER 403.

AN ACT to allow Nathan J. Lankford, late Sheriff and Collector of Somerset county, further time to complete his collections. Passed March 9, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Nathan J. Lankford, late Sheriff of Somerset county, be and he is hereby authorised, within twelve months from the passage of this act, to complete his collections as Sheriff and Collector of the State and County Taxes; *Provided,* that nothing herein contained shall be construed to extend the time of paying over any money due from said Lankford, as sheriff or collector, as aforesaid. Further time to complete collections.
 Proviso.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 404.

AN ACT to regulate the compensation of the County Commissioners of Montgomery county. Passed March 8, 1858.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Montgomery county, be and they are hereby allowed each three dollars for every day they may be in session for business, and also, five cents mileage for every mile in going to the place of business, but no mileage in returning. Compensation.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall go into effect only after the expiration of the term of office of the present County Commissioners of Montgomery county. To go into effect.
