AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the Government, for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty.

priated.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That for the expenditure in the support of the government for the year ending on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and sixty, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say: for the salary of the Governor of the State, three thousand six hundred dollars; for the salary of the Secretary of State, one thousand dollars; for the salary of the Comptroller of the Treasury Department, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Treasurer of this State, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land office, two hundred dollars; for the salaries of the Judges of the Court of Appeals, ten thousand dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the First Judicial Circuit, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Third Judicial Circuit, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Fourth Judicial Circuit, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Superior Court for Baltimore city, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Court of Common Pleas for Baltimore city, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Circuit Court for Baltimore city, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Judge of the Sixth Judicial Circuit, two
