cancy that may occur in their body by death, resignation or otherwise, that is to say: that they or a majority of them after giving at least fifteen days notice by publication in such newspapers and and by such other mode as they, in their discretion, shall deem most conducive to the interest of their enterprise, shall or may open a book or books at such place or places as they may designate, for receiving subscriptions to the capital stock to construct a bridge across Miles River in Talbot county, at or near the site of the present ferry; and thereupon they or any member of their board shall proceed to receive subscriptions to the capital stock of the company, by this act incorporated; the said stock to be limited to fifteen thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of twenty five dollars each; and the said books shall be kept open as long as the said Commissioners or a majority of them shall deem prudent.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That as soon as two hundred shares of the capital stock of the company created by this act shall have been subscribed, the said Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall call a meeting of the subscribers to said capital stock, who shall proceed either in person, or by proxy, to the election by ballot of one president and four directors from among their own body to manage the affairs of said company for one year from the day of their election, and until a new election of president and directors shall thereafter be made.

President and Directors to be elected.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the said stockholders, their associates and successors, from the day of their first meeting, as hereinbefore provided for, shall and they are hereby declared to be a body corporate and politic, by the name, style and title of the "Miles River Bridge Company," and by that name shall have succession, may sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded, answer and be answered unto, in any court of law or equity in this State.
