SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of Maryland pay upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to Ellen Shank, a soldier of the Maryland Line, during the Revolution, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, being the arrears of pension for five years preceding the passage of this act, and in addition thereto he pay to the said Ellen Shank, an annuity of thirty dollars per annum for the remainder of her life.
