

law, for the election of local trustees for the other free schools in said county, and the said trustees, so elected, shall exercise all the powers now vested in local trustees of free schools in said county, and hold for the term of one year, from the time of their election.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from its passage. In force.

CHAPTER 431.

AN ACT to widen the public road from Georgetown to Georgetown Cross Roads, and from Chesterville and Massey's Cross Roads to Georgetown Cross Roads, in Kent county, and to straighten the road from Chesterville to Georgetown Cross Roads.

Passed March 6, 1853.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners for Kent county, be and they are hereby authorised and required to appoint three persons, residents of the Third Election District in said county, "commissioners" to whom they shall issue a commission to enter upon, go over, and examine the public roads leading from Georgetown and from Chesterville and from Massey's Cross Roads to Georgetown Cross Roads, and to ascertain and determine whether the said roads shall be widened, and the road from Chesterville to Georgetown Cross Roads should also be straightened, and that the said commissioners, when so appointed and qualified according to the requirements of the act of Assembly, of January session, eighteen hundred and fifty-three, chapter two hundred and twenty, entitled an act granting the County Commissioners of the several counties of this State, the power to open, alter and close roads in their respective counties, relating to examiners, shall have and exercise all the powers and authority of examiners under the said act, and after their qualification,

County Commissioners authorised to appoint three residents of the third election district as commissioners to examine public roads.
