CHAPTER 61.

Passed February 20, 1858.

AN ACT entitled an act allowing a pension to Esther Williams, a widow of the late Henry Williams, a soldier of the Maryland Line during the Revolutionary War, and appropriating a sum of money for the payment thereof.

Treasurer to pay.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Treasurer of Maryland pay, upon the warrant of the Comptroller, to Esther Williams, widow of Henry Williams, a soldier of the Maryland Line, during the Revolution, the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, being the arrears of pension for five years preceding the passage of this act; and in addition thereto, he pay to the said Esther Williams, an annuity of thirty dollars per annum for the remainder of her natural life.

CHAPTER 62.

Passed February 3, 1858.

AN ACT entitled an act for the benefit of Catherine Wistel, widow of Robert Purtle, a soldier of the Maryland Line, during the Revolution.
