Wages of la-Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assemborers. adeas bly of Maryland, That hereafter in the annual levy by the county Commissioners of Prince George's county, they shall allow to persons working as laborers on the roads of said county the following rates; to a man hand, one dollar and twenty-five cents per day; to a woman hand, one dollar per day, to a boy, not less than ten years of age, seventy-five cents per day; for one yoke of oxen and cart, with driver, two dollars and fifty cents per day; and for plow and two horses with plowman, two dollars and fifty cents per day. Repealed.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all laws inconsistent with this act, be and they are hereby repealed.
