McKim, widow of Alexander McKim, a private in the Cavalry, in the war of the Revolution, be and she is hereby allowed a pension, equal to the half pay of a private in the Cavalry, in consideration of the services of her husband in the said war.

And be it enacted, That the sum of Sum appropriated. three hundred and sixty dollars, being equal to the half pay of a private in the cavalry, for six years, commencing on the first day of January, eighteen hundred and fifty-one, is hereby appropriated; and the Treasurer upon the warrant of the Comptroller, is hereby directed to pay the said sum of money, to Catherine S.
