

## LAWS OF MARYLAND.

## CHAPTER 70.

Passed February 23, 1858.

A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT TO AN ACT passed at December session, eighteen hundred and forty-nine, chapter 177, entitled an act to reduce the present rates of premiums on wolf, wild cat and foxes' scalps, in Allegany county.

Premium for fox and wolf scalps.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That from and after the passage of this act, Commissioners of Allegany county shall levy and pay for each and every fox scalp taken in Allegany county, the sum of one dollar; and for each and every wolf scalp taken in said county, the sum of twenty dollars; *Provided,* the person or persons taking such fox or wolf scalps, shall prove and authenticate them in the same manner as prescribed by the original act and its supplements.

Proviso.

Repealed.

Sec. 2. *And be it enacted,* That so much of the act of eighteen hundred and forty-nine, chapter 177, section 1st, which is inconsistent with this act, be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.

## CHAPTER 71.

Passed February 5, 1858.

AN ACT to make valid the election and ordinances of the Burgess and Commissioners of Mechanicstown, Frederick county.
