

houses of other persons in said village without the consent of their master or mistress.

Treasurer to be appointed.

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners or a majority of them, shall have full power and authority to appoint a Treasurer for the said corporation, who shall give bond to said corporate body, with security to be approved by the Commissioners or a majority of them in such penalty as they shall fix, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duty as Treasurer; and he shall receive and pay any moneys according to the ordinance passed by the said corporation, or a majority of them.

Fines—how applied.

SEC. 18. *And be it enacted*, That all fines and forfeitures imposed by the said Commissioners, by virtue of any law or ordinance be applied in such manner for the use of said village as may be from time to time, by ordinance directed.

No compensation allowed.

SEC. 19. *And be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners, to be hereafter elected, under the provisions of this act, shall receive no compensation for their services.

Not to exercise banking privileges.

SEC. 20. *And be it enacted*, That nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to authorise the corporation hereby created, to issue any device, token, note, certificate or evidence of debt to be used as currency; and the Legislature reserves the right to amend or repeal this charter when the same shall be deemed advisable.

In force.

SEC. 21. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
