298. An act to confirm and make valid a deed from Clement St. Jones and Josiah Massey, and wife, to Thomas H. Copper.

299. An act for the benefit of Elizabeth Mills, the legal representative of Henry Gassaway, late of Anne Arundel county, deceased.

300. An act relating to the vestry of St. Peter's church, in the city of Baltimore.

301. An act to regulate the inspection of tobacco, in the city of Baltimore, and to prescribe the duties of the inspectors, and for other purposes.

302. An act to amend an act passed at December session, 1849, chapter 358, entitled, an act to incorporate the Union Plank Road and Turnpike Company.

303. An act appropriating a sum of money to pay Thomas J. Wilson, for legal services rendered the State, at the instance and request of the Comptroller, in the trial of the case of Schley vs. the Comptroller of the Treasury, in the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel county.

304. An act to authorise James H. Thomas, of St. Mary's county, a free negro, to dispose of his real and personal estate by last will and testament, or alienate the same by deed or other conveyance.

305. An act for the relief of the heirs and personal representatives of Joshua M. Turner, late of Baltimore city, deceased.

306. An act authorising the appointment of an inspector of lumber, at Bell's ferry, in the second election district, of Harford county.

307. An act to prevent slaves from gaining their freedom in certain cases.

308. An act to make valid certain deeds, and to regulate the recording of the same.

309. An act for the relief of Thomas Pierpoint, and the legal representatives of Jacob Sedley and Francis Freeburger.
