WHEREAS, It is represented to this General As-Preamble. sembly, that William Johnson, a free negro, of Calvert county, has by his industry, economy and good conduct acquired certain real and personal estate in said county, which he is desirous of transmitting by his last will and testament, but which under existing laws of this State he is unable to do, therefore,

Authorised to Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assemdispose of. bly of Maryland, That the said William Johnson be and he is hereby authorised to devise, bequeath and dispose of his said real and personal estate by his last will and testament; and the person or persons to whom he may devise or bequeath the same, are hereby authorized and empowered to have, hold, occupy, possess, inherit and enjoy the said real and personal estate as fully as the lawful descendants of other persons now do, any law, usage, or custom to the contrary notwithstanding. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
