Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Caleb S. Keech, administrator of Thomas P. Turner, deceased, former Deputy Sheriff of Prince George's county, be and he is hereby authorised and empowered to collect by execution, and to receive all and every balance or amount of officers' fees, chancery taxes, legal costs, fines and forfeitures, and all other sums which were due to and remained uncollected by the said Thomas P. Turner, as Deputy Sheriff, of Prince George's county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That if any person Personagainst against whom there is a claim by said adminstration of the claim to make tor shall make affidavit before any Justice of the affidavit.
