4. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the existing trustees shall meet Existing trustees. at the aforesaid court-house, on the first Tuesday of July next, tees o deliver and deliver over to their successors, to be taken under their care over property. and management, all books and papers, and a schedule of all and singular the property belonging to the aforesaid poor-house, under the penalty of forty dollars each, to be recovered and applied as other fines and forfeitures are directed to be recovered and applied

in the aforesaid original act to which this is a supplementary act.

5. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the trustees for the poor to be leges, &c. appointed in virtue of this act, and their successors in that capacity hereby constituted the trustees for the poor of Worcester county, shall respectively, forever have, hold, use, exercise and enjoy all the powers, authorities, rights, property, liberties, privileges and immunities which have hitherto been possessed, enjoyed and used, and shall be subject to all the penalties for neglect of the duties of trustees for the poor of said county, as are mentioned and declared in the said original act to which this is a supplementary act, except the power of appointing new trustees, or filling up casual vacancies in their own board, and except so far as the same may be varied or limited by the provisions of this act. And the poor-house situated in the same county, and the lands, tenements, goods and chattels thereto appertainining and belonging, shall be, and the same are hereby vested in the trustees for the poor of the said county, and their successors in that capacity to be appointed in virtue of this act, to and for the uses and purposes mentioned and declared in this act, and in the original act to which this is a supplementary act.

6. AND BE IT ENACTED, That in all cases of vacanies happening Vacancies. by non-acceptance, death, resignation, removal out of the county, or disqualification of any of the said trustees, the vacancies thereby occasioned shall be filled up by the levy court of the said county,

at their next meeting which shall happen thereafter.

7. AND BE IT ENACTED, That it shall be the duty of the trus- Accounts to be tees for the poor to be appointed in virtue of this act, under the rendered annupenalty of fifty dollars each, to be recovered and applied as herein before directed, to make out and render to the said levy court, at their first meeting in the month of April in each and every year, a statement of their accounts and expenditures, with the necessary vouchers, for the preceding year; which accounts shall be passed and settled by the said levy court, previous to the making the new appointments of trustees for the ensuing year.

8. And BE IT ENACTED, That the trustees for the poor to be Overseer duappointed under this act, shall, at their first meeting in July next, and at their annual meeting in May thereafter, proceed to appoint an overseer of the poor of said county according to the provisions of the eleventh section of the original act to which this act is a supplement. And also, to appoint one of their own body clerk to the trustees for the poor of said county, whose duty it shall be to keep the accounts of the said trustees for the poor, and to prepare all necessary statements for settlement with the levy court; and for whose compensation the said court may allow such sum as they shall think just.
