CHAPTER 200.

An act authorising the laying off ground and extending thereon the Passed Feb. 22, public wharf at New-Town in Worcester county.

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED By the General Assembly of Maryland, That Commissioners Peter Holland, Giles Jones, John Hargis, Ephraim K. Wilson, -to lav off and Irving Spence, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out, survey, mark and bound a sufficiency of ground adjoining the public wharf at New-Town in Worcester county, to make said wharf of such size and extent as the public interest may in their judgment require, and in such way as will be least prejudicial to the interests of the present holders of the property on which said wharf may be made.

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the said commissioners, or a Damages. majority of them, shall ascertain the damages which any person or persons may sustain by reason of the said wharf being laid out from his, her or their lands, which shall be first paid or secured to be paid by the persons interested in laying out said wharf, before the said wharf be made public.

3. AND BEIT ENACTED, That the said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby directed to return a plot of the said public. wharf, when surveyed, marked and laid out as aforesaid, to the clerk of the county court, to be by him recorded; which wharf, when laid out, shall be deemed and taken as a public wharf forever thereafter, and shall be kept up and repaired as all other public wharfs in said county are; *Provided*, That nothing herein contained Proviso. shall in any manner authorise the said commissioners to lay out the said wharf through the buildings, garden, orchard or yard, of any person or persons, without his, her or their consent, or if minors, without the consent of his, her or their guardian.

4. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the persons interested in laying Expense to be out the said wharf, shall pay to the commissioners the reasonable paid by persons expenses for surveying and laying out the said ground for a public interested. wharf, and making out and returning the said plot.

CHAPTER 201.

An act to incorporate The Savage Manufacturing Company. SEC. 1.
