SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED By the General Assembly of Maryland, That the scheme or schemes of the lottery or lotteries authorised empt from tax. by the act to which this is a supplement, shall be excepted from the provisions of the act entitled, An act to regulate lotteries, and the several supplements thereto, so far as the same impose or direct that a tax shall be paid on the prizes to be drawn in said lottery or lotteries, and as to the time of drawing imposed by the said
