Notice.

3. And be it enacted, That the sheriff of Anne Arundel county shall give notice of the place of holding the election in each election district so laid off anew, by causing the same to be inserted in one of the newspapers of the city of Annapolis, once a week, for at least two months previous to holding the election in October, eighteen hundred and twenty-four.

Vacancy.

4. And be it enacted, That if any of the commissioners named in this act shall refuse to accept his appointment before the first day of March, eighteen hundred and twenty-four, the remaining commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby authorised and directed to fill such vacancy or vacancies.

Compensation.

5. And be it enacted, That each commissioner shall be entitled to receive at the rate of two dollars per day, for every day he shall act in the discharge of the duties imposed on him by the provisions of this act, to be assessed and levied by the levy court of Anne Arundel county, as other county charges are; which said sums, when levied and collected, shall be paid over as other county charges are.

Constitutional proviso.

6. And be it enacted, That if this act shall be confirmed by the general assembly of Maryland, after the next election of delegates, during the first session after such new election as the constitution and form of government directs, in such case this act and the alterations herein contained shall constitute and be considered as a part of the constitution and form of government, to all intents and purposes, any thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

Passed Feb An act respecting the last will and testament of Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer.

Register directed.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall be the duty of the register of wills for Charles county, and he is hereby directed and required, immediately to transmit to the clerk of the court of appeals for the Western Shore, the original last will and testament of Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer, first making and retaining in his office a true and correct copy thereof.

Clerk of court of appeals di-rected.

2. And be it enacted, That the clerk of the court of appeals be, and he is hereby required and directed to receive the said will, and attach it to the record transmitted to the court of appeals from the orphans' court of Charles county, in which Daniel Jenifer and Walter H. Jenifer are appellants, and Frederick D. Stone, executor of Daniel of Saint Thomas Jenifer appellee; and it is hereby directed that the said will, thus transmitted, shall have the same effect and consideration by the court, as if it had made a part of the original record, and the clerk of the court of appeals is hereby directed to return the said will to the register of wills for Charles county, when the case shall have been decided in the court of appeals.
