CHAPTER 91.

*A supplement to the act entitled, an act to appoint Thomas Harris, junior, of the city of Annapolis, trustee for the sale of the real estate of John Gwinn, Esquire, late of the said city, deceased.*

SEC. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That if it shall appear to the orphans' court of Anne Arundel county, that the interest which hath arisen, or which may arise upon the stock purchased or to be purchased by the trustee under the directions of the orphan's court aforesaid, in pursuance of the act to which this is a supplement, hath not been or shall not be sufficient for the support, maintenance and education of the children of the said John Gwinn, or either of them during their minority, and that the said trustee hath advanced or shall advance to the mother and natural guardian of the said children, during their minority, a part of the proceeds of the sales of the real estate, over and beyond the interest arising or to arise from the stock purchased by him under the directions of the orphans' court aforesaid, then the said orphans' court shall and may sanction and approve of the advance so made and to be made as aforesaid, or of such part thereof, as they shall deem necessary and sufficient for the support, maintenance and education of the said children or either of them, during their minority, and the said trustee shall be credited with, and allowed in the settlement of his trust as aforesaid, such sum or sums of money as shall be sanctioned and approved by the orphans' court as aforesaid.
