An act for the support of James Upton, James Catterton and Clare Stone.

Sum to be levied for James Upton.

Sec. 1. BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the justices of the levy court of Baltimore county, shall and they are hereby empowered at their next levy, and at their levy court annually, during the life of the said James Upton, to levy on the assessable property of said county, the sum of thirty dollars for the support of the said James Upton, and that the same be collected annually by the collector or the collectors of Baltimore county, and paid to the said James Upton or to his order.

Sum to be le-vied for James Catterton,

2. AND BE IT ENACTED, That the justices of the levy court of Calvert county, be and they are hereby authorised and directed to assess and levy annually on the assessable property of said county, the sum of twenty five dollars, for the support and maintenance of James Catterton of said county, and that the same be collected annually by the collector of said county and paid to the said James Catterton or his order in quarterly payments.
